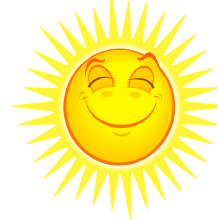


Parent Board

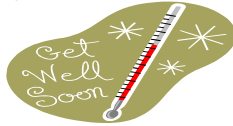


Vacation Time and Absences
